

Money Skills- Decision Making Patch

Girls develop a basic business plan for product sales and work as a team to decide when and where to sell and what to do with the money earned.

Because your Girl Scout helps decide how her troop/group will spend their money...

- She can decide how to use her babysitting money—spend some, save some; give some to those in need.
- As she grows up, she'll know when and how to give back to her community. An important part of Girl Scouting is giving back.

Activities- Complete three of the five activities below

- 1. How does your troop make decisions about spending troop money? Do you take a vote, have a committee that decides what is best for the troop or some other way?
- 2. Talk about needs versus wants. With a set budget, how do you decide what to buy?
- 3. What decisions did you get to make during the sale? i.e. Who to ask to make a purchase? Where to have a cookie booth? How your troop spends their money or something else?
- 4. What things does your troop get to decide during the year, other than how to spend cookie money?
- 5. How does your troop/group decide on choosing a community service project?
