Hello Troop MagNut Chairs,

Happy Tuesday! Friday is the start of the Fall Product Program. Thank you for all the support you have provided to your troop so far. This your MagNut News for the week – your e-newsletter for updates, reminders, and information during the 2024 Fall Product Program. Here's the top 5 pieces of information you need for the week.

**1. Girl Scouts ready to participate in MagNuts will be available in M2OS on Thursday.** We will do another upload of Girl Scouts into M2OS on Wednesday, September 25<sup>th</sup>. The Google sheets are being updated daily, so please feel free to check those as well to see who has submitted a product permission form. The lists are current as of 9/24 at 11:30 AM. We will do uploads Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays throughout the course of the program.

**2. Don't forget to log into the M2 Operating System (M2OS).** On Thursday, please check to make sure your Girl Scouts that have turned in product permission forms by September 22<sup>nd</sup> are listed in M2OS. As a reminder, when viewing the Service Unit Google sheet, Girl Scouts who have been uploaded to M2OS have their troop number highlighted green. If a Girl Scout is highlighted green and not appearing in M2OS, please let us know. Please make sure the correct Girl Scouts are listed in your troop. If there is a Girl Scout that should not be in your troop, please email [customercare@nmgirlscouts.org](mailto:customercare@nmgirlscouts.org) and we will make sure they get into the right troop.

**3. Parent/Guardian Email Blast.** On Thursday, set up your Parent/Guardian Email Blast in M2OS. These emails will begin hitting parents' inboxes throughout the day on Friday, September 27<sup>th</sup>. If troop chairs do not set this up, families will not get emails to set up their online accounts until Saturday. You may have new girls added into the system since your first login so please double check. A video with precise instructions is available on the MagNut Central Website. **4. Families Needing Help Setting-Up Their Site.** I have attached an instructional flyer that you can share with families to help them set up their websites. 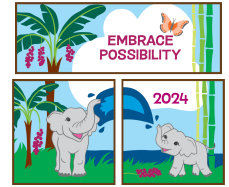

## How the Fall Product Program Works:

This program allows Girl Scouts to be entrepreneurs by offering family and friends the opportunity to purchase from a variety of products. There are two ways to participate:

- In-person by taking orders using the nut order card and collecting payments.
- Online by inviting friends and family to place an order. Customers can choose to have nuts, chocolates, magazines, Tervis® Tumblers or a Girl Scout themed BarkBox shipped directly to them or they can select from a group of nut and chocolate products that Girl Scouts can deliver.

## Important Dates:

- **9/27/24:** Program begins – online ordering opens and Girl Scouts may sell in-person.
- **10/20/24:** Last day of order taking with the order card AND deadline to enter the items sold into the online system.
- **10/24/24:** Last day for online girl delivery orders.
- **10/24/24:** Last day for online shipped orders.
- **11/11 - 11/18:** Nut and chocolate items will be delivered to Service Unit sites.

**Height:** 6 to 12 feet tall at the shoulder

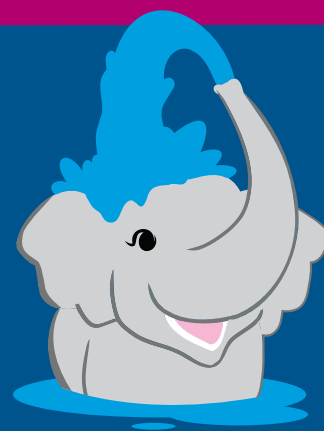
**Weight:** 4,400 – 12,000 pounds
