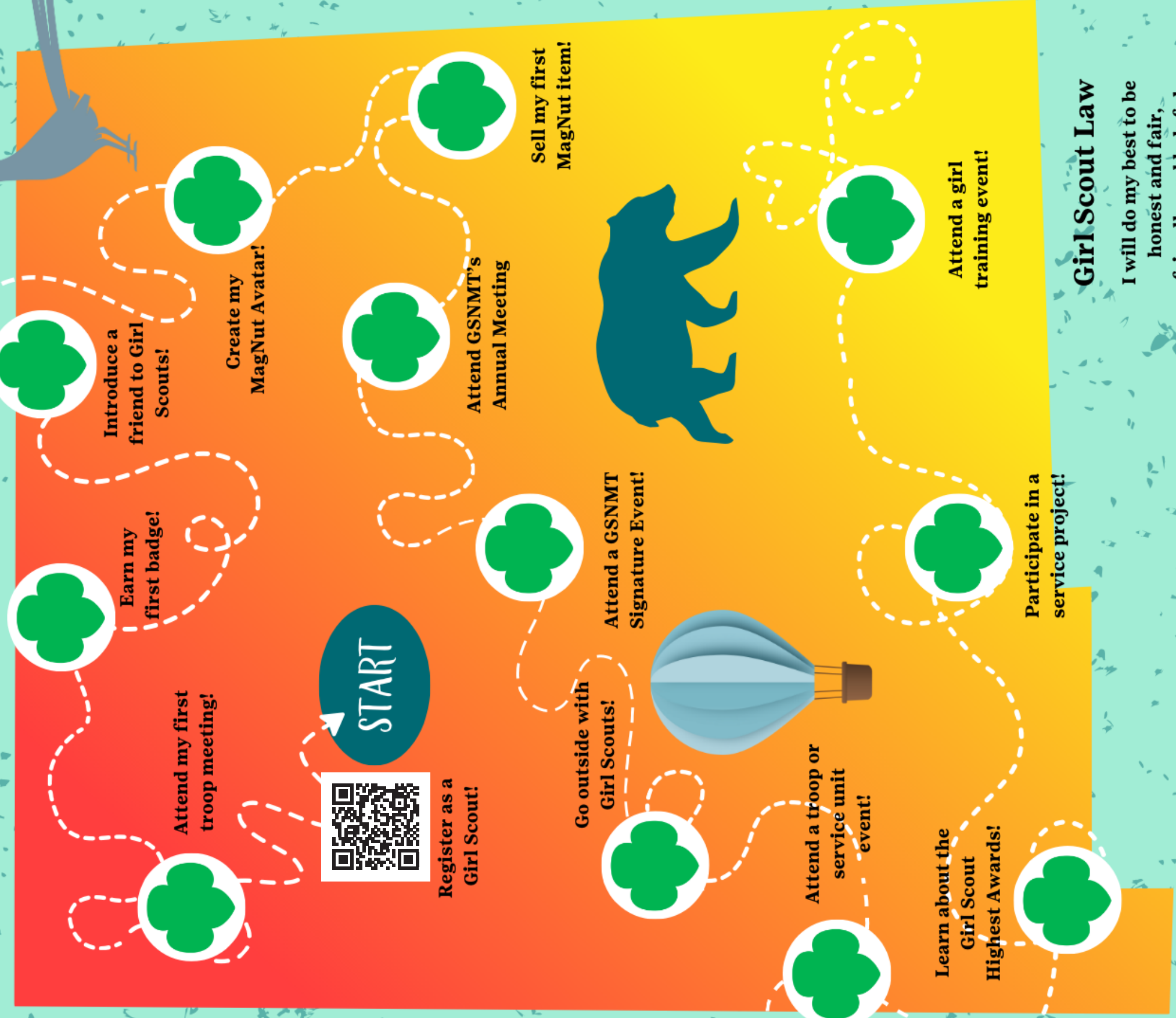

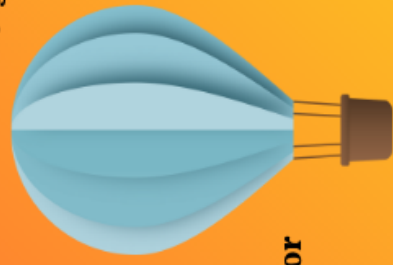
- Daisies - Kindergarden & First Grade
