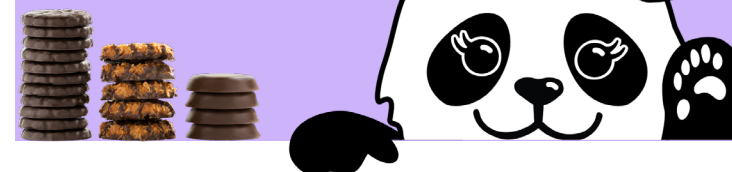
This key will help you understand grade levels and the corresponding symbols to pick the events that are just right for you or your troop/group:

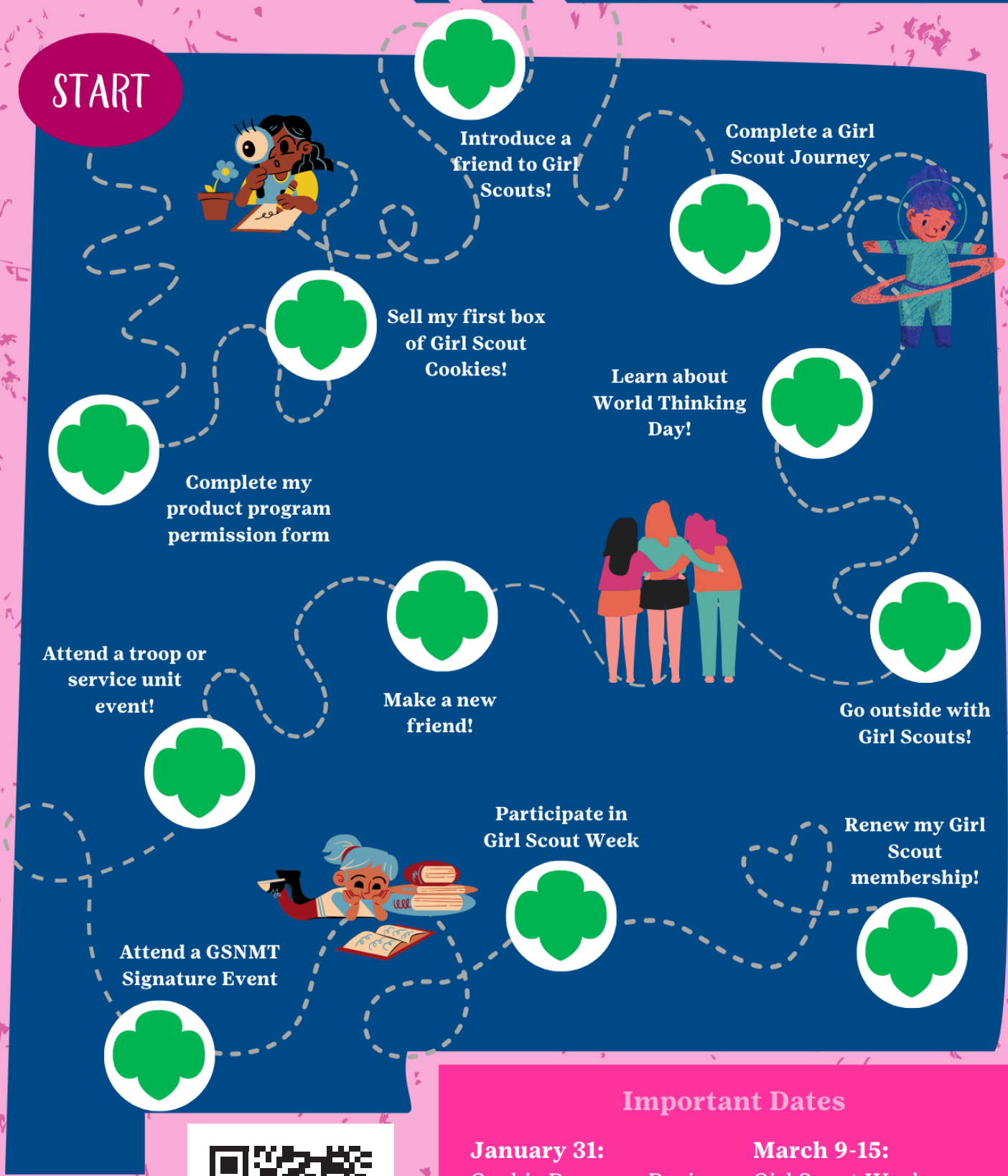
